Biały Dunajec, Poland. January 27 – February 2.
Thank you for your prayers. These were encouraging days! We are celebrating 30 years of ministry in Poland. It is exciting to see the current generation being equipped to make an even greater impact in the next 30 years. This Polish team is so talented! We are now working in four communities. Each week around 100-150 youths and leaders gather for ministry. Our team is spread throughout Poland (and the USA!). God is building his army of witnesses in this land. FOOTHILLS CHRISTIAN LIFE CENTER HAPPENINGS

Each Sunday morning a faithful group of attendees and ministry team workers meet for Breakfast Bible Fellowship. We enjoy a great buffet-style meal and then hear a message on a relevant topic from God's Word. Over the last six months we have been exploring topics that essential to the Christian life. Currently, we are completing a short series on how God guides us in life. The series has focused on the ancient Israelites in the wilderness. We have adapted their lessons to our lives. We're excited to see great progress on targeted renovations in our Family Rec Hall. There is a 4-lane bowling alley directly beneath the basketball court (see below). Wall repair and painting are well underway. Alley gutters, ceiling, and floor are yet to be repainted. Lighting will be also be upgraded to LED. Some minor repairs to the equipment will be made. Lord willing, the lanes will be open in the fall to nearby families! This is another great connection point as we seek to be a "center" point for family life.



During the past few years we have offered a men's "pick-up" style basketball league. Due to the popularity of the program we now dedicate two nights each week during the winter months for this activity. The facility is also popular with youth basketball programs and Little League teams in search of facilities to have weekly practice times for their teams. The gym is open nearly every night during the winter to accommodate these activities. FCLC is back on the "map" as many parents and participants discover that the former St. Anthony church is under new ownership as a friendly and caring Christian mission.
